Frequently Asked Questions Spring 2026

Q: What is TOPSoccer Plus?

A: TOPSoccer (The Outreach Program for Soccer) is an inclusive program that brings the joy of soccer to individuals with intellectual, emotional, or physical disabilities. With the support of US Youth Soccer, it has grown from a grassroots effort into one of the most respected adaptive sports programs in the country.

TOPSoccer Plus is a new level of the program started in Madison–Ridgeland, Mississippi for players who have aged out of the traditional TOPSoccer program. It allows these players to continue enjoying the friendships, community, and activity that TOPSoccer provides.

The program focuses on safe, low-impact activities such as “Sit and Kick,” “Toss to Score,” and other adapted games that encourage social interaction and light exercise while minimizing the risk of injury.

Q: How, where, and when are the games played?

A: TOPSoccer Plus will be played on Wednesday mornings from 9:30 AM to 10:30 AM at Freedom Ridge Park in Ridgeland. The season will run April 22 through May 13. Activities will take place on the Stadium Field, the first soccer field you see when entering the park.

Each session is organized into activity stations. Every player will be paired with a volunteer who will escort them between stations. Players may spend as much or as little time at each station as they wish, allowing them to participate at their own pace.

Q: How do I register, what does it cost, and who is the contact?

A: Registration runs from March 14 through April 22, 2026. There is no cost to participate in TOPSoccer Plus.
